An update to Impact Factors



This past week saw the publication of the 2019 Journal Citation Reports ([Clarivate 2020](#)) and the corresponding Impact Factors. All journals published as part of the Geological Society of London's Lyell Collection are included within the Journal Citation Reports.

Broadly, Impact Factors remained steady across the GSL portfolio, with some fluctuations as is expected. Notably, Quarterly Journal of Engineering Geology and Hydrology increased to a new high (1.897) and Journal of Geological Society retained its level above 3.

As readers are aware, the Impact Factor is just one of a number of metrics and items of information that can be used in building a picture of a journal. GSL is a signatory to the San Francisco Declaration on Research Assessment ([DORA](#)) and, as such, is committed to the balanced and transparent presentation of journal metrics and information in order to best serve our communities.

Off-site access to subscribed to Lyell content through CASA extended to end of September

In response to many universities and institutions enforcing a policy encouraging students and staff to work remotely, HighWire, working with Google Scholar, has made an extension to the time-to-live for CASA (Campus Activated Subscriber Access) tokens.

Users who had off-campus access in March will retain that off-campus subscription access through to the end of September. Previously the expiration date was the end of July.

This allows authorized staff and students to access their subscribed Journals and Books until the end of September.
